The scenery is beautiful and it is close to a lot of places in Seoul






- Not saying bless you after sneezing

When you meet people in my homecountry, you introduce yourself with a handshake and here you just wave


- The safety during the night when you are a girl

Wanted to stay one semester, tried to extend my stay but unfortunately it was not possible. But I know that first I will travel Asia and then the other continents.


I've always wanted to live in Korea and develop my career here.

about my future and I want to


travel to Asia more often.
