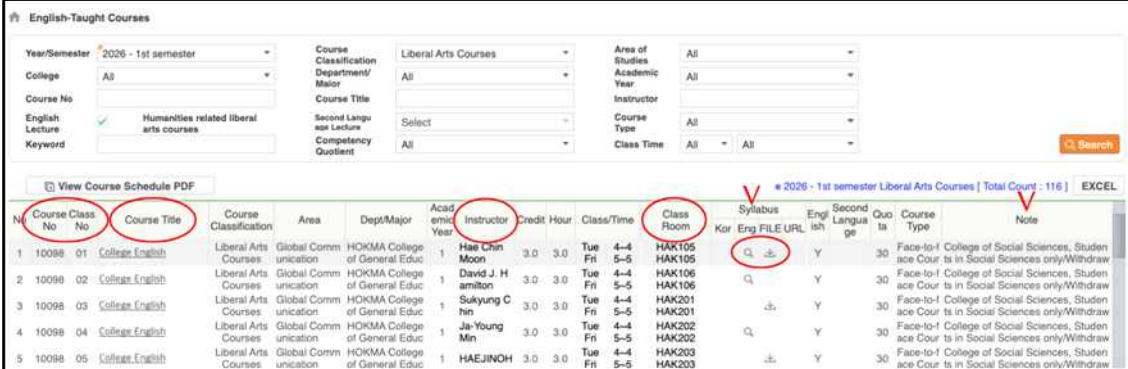

the [Syllabus] column to view the syllabus and check the [Note] column for detailed course information (e.g., prerequisites, restrictions, etc.).

IV. Method of Course Registration

All course-related processes are conducted entirely online through the Ewha Student Portal. Course registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and can be highly competitive depending on the course. Therefore, students are strongly advised to register as soon as the registration period begins.

1-1. Course Registration & Course Change

* Registration: Aug 27, 9:00-17:00 / Change: Sep 1, 9:00 - Sep 7, 15:00

1) Access to Ewha Student Portal (<https://portal.ewha.ac.kr>)

2) Login with ID & Password:

- Access to the portal will be available starting on **August 10, 9AM.**

- ID: Student ID (IES26***) / Password: Last six digits of the birth (YYMMDD)

※ Students are required to change their password after their initial log-in. Please keep your new password in a secure place. If you forget your password, please contact the Ewha OIA at goabroad@ewha.ac.kr to request a password reset.

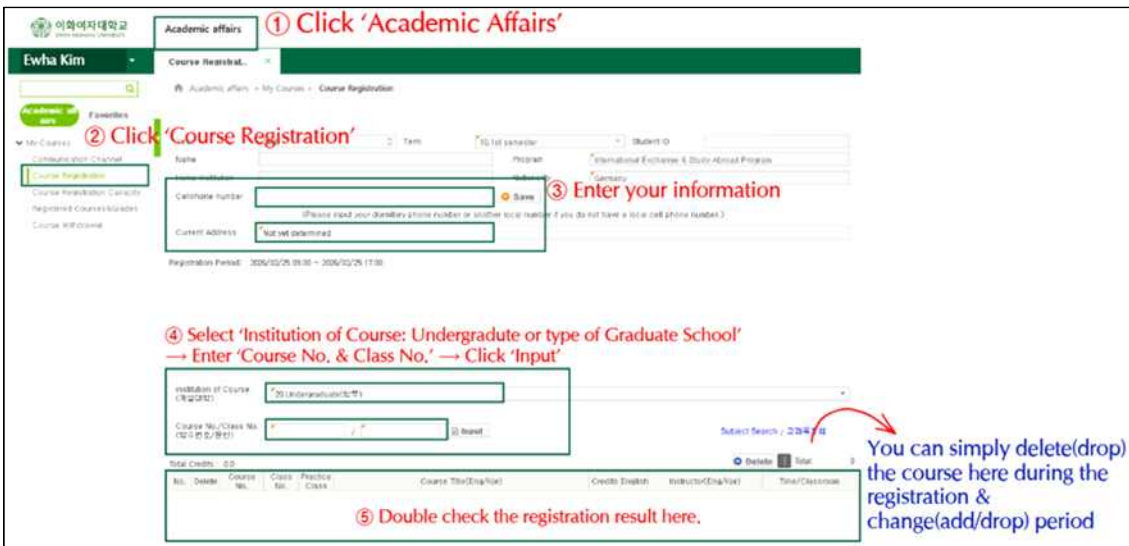
3) Click [Eureka] > [Academic Affairs] > [My Courses] > [Course Registration]

4) Enter your information (Cell phone number & Korean address), only required at first.

5) Select [Institution of Course] by clicking 'Undergraduate' or 'type of Graduate School' > Enter [Course No.] & [Class No.] > Click [Input]

- The class quota is divided into two categories: Exchange/Visiting Students and Non-Exchange/Visiting Students(for degree-seeking students). The quota for Exchange/Visiting Students will be finalized and available before the course registration period begins (expected on August 26 (Wed); the exact date will be announced later).
- Students can only enroll in courses that have remaining spots for Exchange/Visiting Students. (If the "Total Spots" for Exchange/Visiting Students is 0(zero), the course is not open to Exchange/Visiting Students; therefore, you cannot enroll in the course.)
- All quotas will be merged during the last three business days of the course change (add/drop) period, starting on September 3. During this period, you may register for any remaining Non-Exchange Student spots in addition to Exchange/Visiting Student spots. However, courses with an initial "Total Spots" for Exchange/Visiting Students of 0 (zero) remain unavailable to Exchange/Visiting Students, as they are not open to Exchange/Visiting Students.

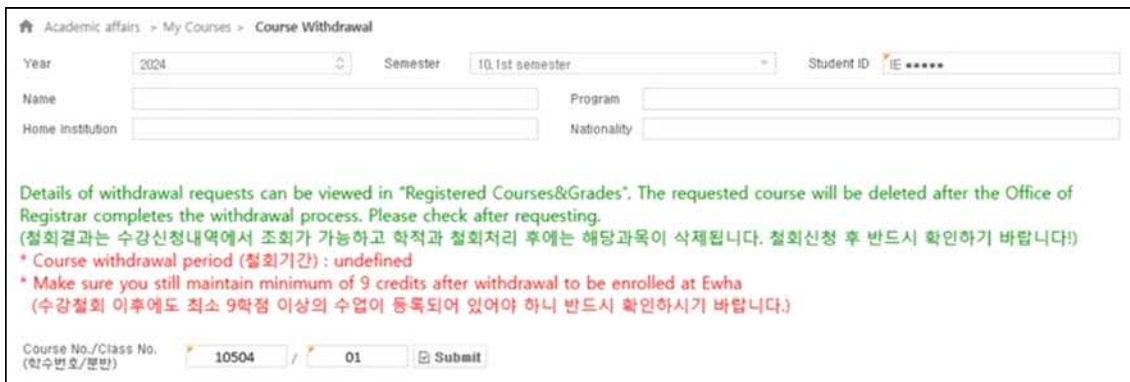
